Simply obtain a B709B Form from your local Police weapons registry and take the original to the relevant office of the Australian Border Force when the goods are imported into Australia.</p> <p>If you are applying for permission to import under any other test specified at Schedule 13 (Part 1) of the Import Regulations this form is required along with additional information dependant on the test which the importation complies with.</p> <p>Further information regarding what supporting documentation must be submitted with this form can be found at www.abf.gov.au</p>
Timeframes	<p>Applications must be lodged prior to importation and goods cannot be imported until permission to import has been approved.</p> <p>Applications take approximately four weeks for processing once all relevant information is received.</p> <p>If your application does not include all the required documentation, processing time may be longer.</p>
