

Australian Customs Notice No. 2023/27

Increase to Biosecurity Cost Recovery Charge

This Notice advises of changes to the biosecurity cost recovery charge on Full Import Declarations (FIDs) for goods arriving in Australia by air and sea, and replaces <u>Australian Customs Notice No. 2022/50</u>.

From 1 July 2023, the biosecurity cost recovery charge for goods arriving by air and sea will be increased to \$43.00 and \$63.00, respectively. This only applies to imported goods with a customs value over AUD1000.

The Australian Border Force collects the biosecurity cost recovery charge through the Integrated Cargo System, on behalf of the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF). The new charge rates, reflected in the table below, will apply to imports from 1 July 2023.

Charge	Current charge	New charge from 1 July 2023	Who is affected?
Full Import Declaration charge – air	AUD38	AUD43	Customs brokers and importers of consignments over AUD1000
Full Import Declaration charge – sea	AUD58	AUD63	Customs brokers and importers of consignments over AUD1000
