Australian Customs Notice No. 2026/23

Increase to Biosecurity Cost Recovery Charge

This Notice advises of changes to the biosecurity cost recovery charge on Full Import declarations (FIDs) for goods arriving in Australia by air and sea and replaces [Australian Customs Notice 2025-16 Increase to Biosecurity Cost Recovery Charge](#).

From 1 July 2026, the biosecurity cost recovery charge for goods arriving by air and sea will be increased to \$48.00 and \$71.00, respectively. This only applies to imported goods with a customs value over \$1,000.

The Australian Border Force collects the biosecurity cost recovery charge through the Integrated Cargo System, on behalf of the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF). The new charge rates, reflected in the table below, will apply to imports from 1 July 2026.

Charge	Current Charge	New charge from 1 July 2026	Who is affected
Full Import Declaration charge - air	\$46.00	\$48.00	Customs brokers and importers of consignments over \$1,000
Full Import Declaration charge - sea	\$68.00	\$71.00	Customs brokers and importers of consignments over \$1,000
