# (Cisco based secure email system via Telstra SIG gateway)

Note: These instructions replace the Trend Secure Email system guide that related to the Verizon Gateway system - superceded Dec 2014

## LOGGING ON FOR THE FIRST TIME

Step1: You will receive a notification email from the ACBPS sender with the encrypted message as a file attachment as in the following example:

### **Step 4: Activate Your CRES Account**

Check your email inbox for an activation message from the service. If the email is not in your inbox, check the spam or junk email folder in case the activation message was filtered, registration messages will come from DoNotReply@res.cisco.com. The following example shows a typical activation message.

#### Step Five: View the Registered Envelope Again and Enter Your Password

Return to the Registered Envelope. The Register button is no longer displayed on the envelope. An Open button appears in its place, as shown here.
